1.	<p>Aeronautical Radio Stations may not be established, or used except under the authority of a Wireless Telegraphy (WT) Act Licence issued on behalf of the Office of Communications (“Ofcom”).</p> <p>The Civil Aviation Authority’s Directorate of Airspace Policy issue WT Act Licences for Aeronautical Radio Stations on behalf of Ofcom. 2.	<p>Whilst every effort is made to avoid changing the frequencies once assigned, it is nevertheless sometimes necessary to do so as dictated by frequency planning requirements.</p>
3.	<p>Strict radio operating discipline must be maintained, and operators must hold the appropriate qualification as follows:</p> <p>(i) An Air Traffic Control Service can only be provided by an organisation or person approved to do so in accordance with the Air Navigation Order 2016 Article 180 and then only by the holder of a valid and appropriately endorsed Air Traffic Control Officer’s licence issued in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/340.</p> <p>(ii) A Flight Information Service may only be provided by a person holding a validated Flight Information Service Officer’s licence (CA1745) issued by the Civil Aviation Authority.</p> <p>(iii) Air Ground Communication services and services provided by a Clearance Delivery Officer are not Air Traffic Services, but may only be provided by a person holding a Radio Operator’s Certificate of Competence (CA1308) issued by the Civil Aviation Authority and authorised by the Wireless Telegraphy Act licence holder.</p> <p>For OPC Services the WT Act Licence holder is responsible for ensuring appropriate training and RTF behaviour is maintained.</p> <p>Enquiries regarding operator qualifications should be directed to the ATS Licensing Section, Licensing and Training Standards, Safety Regulation Group, Aviation House, Gatwick Airport, West Sussex, RH6 0YR.
